



Assistant/Associate Professorship Position in Sustainable Finance at ENSAE Paris-CREST

ENSAE Paris and CREST are hiring an Assistant Professor or an Associate Professor in Sustainable finance, with a recognized research activity in this field. Candidates should have an excellent scientific background and significant teaching experience.

Preference will be given to candidates with a quantitative background and broad knowledge of finance, economics, econometrics, at least to the level required to teach these subjects at the undergraduate level. The appointment starts on September 1, 2023. Salary is competitive according to qualifications. Teaching duties are reduced compared to French university standards.

At the Assistant Professor level, the position is attributed for an initial three-year term (during which teaching duties are reduced by half if the PhD was obtained less than 3 years earlier), renewable for another three years (with full teaching duties) before the tenure evaluation based on publication track record as well as teaching feedback. At the level of Associate Professor, the position is permanent.

Candidate Profile

- PhD in Sustainable Finance, other areas of Finance, including Quantitative Finance, or Environmental Economics.
- Publications in leading international journals in Finance and/or Economics on the topic of Sustainable / Climate Finance.
- Ability to teach Sustainable Finance at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and to supervise student projects in this area

- Details of current and future research projects and past teaching activities;
- The names and addresses of at least three French or foreign academic referees who could write a letter of recommendation.
