

POST-DOCTORAL POSITION IN ECONOMETRICS

Position to be filled between September 2026 and December 2026.

The position:

The Center for Research in Economics and Statistics (CREST, École Polytechnique, Groupe ENSAE-ENSAI, CNRS) invites applications for a two-year postdoctoral position in econometrics, starting in September 2026.

The successful candidate will join a research team conducting work in both applied and theoretical econometrics. They will be a full member of the team and will have the freedom to pursue their own research agenda. The candidate will also collaborate with Xavier D'Haultfœuille and Laurent Davezies in teaching econometrics (up to 40 hours per year) to a cohort of highly selected students with a strong background in mathematics. The course material will be fully provided by Xavier D'Haultfœuille and Laurent Davezies, who will teach half of the cohort in French, while the successful candidate will teach the other half in English. The software used for course instruction is R.

Benefits include paid annual leave, flexible working hours, funding to attend workshops and conferences, and the opportunity to contribute to all stages of research projects in experimental economics (conceptualization, design, implementation, analysis, writing, and dissemination).

Most of the work is expected to be conducted at CREST, located in Palaiseau. While remote work is possible on selected days, the position requires a regular on-site presence. CREST is a leading research institution near Paris, France, specializing in interdisciplinary quantitative methods and computational social sciences.
